

OUIMET Peter C. Ouimet, age 49, of Austin, Tex. and formerly a resident of Upper Arlington, died unexpectedly Tuesday, June 30, 2009 at his residence. He was born October 5, 1959 in Windsor, Conn. Peter was an electrical engineer specializing in failure analysis and yield improvement with Freescale/ Motorola Semiconductor, Inc., in Austin for the past ten years. Previously, he was a failure analysis engineer and team leader with IBM in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. and Texas Instruments and Cyrix Corporation in Dallas, Tex.
